USING LINEAR ENTRIES

FORMAT

Use the Fast Path linear exchange entries to bypass all of the mask screens. The Fast Path linear entries are only valid for tickets:

- which are completely unused (your agency is responsible for verification of ticket coupon status)
- that exist in the Sabre system's ticket database

One document per passenger only, conjunctive tickets are considered one document.

 Exchange a ticket and include form of payment and change fee
 WFRE(13-digit ticket number)‡F(form of payment)‡CP(change fee amount)

 Note: form of payment is mandatory when there is an additional collection.

Choose a ticket for reissue from a list of multiple ticket images in the database	WFR*L(line number) WFR*L2
	Note: Use this entry to chose the correct ticket image when your original WFR entry displays a list of multiple images.

Display the Price Quote Reissue (PQR) record details	*PQR
Display Price Quote Reissue (PQR) record history	*PQRH
Issue a ticket using a Price Quote Reissue record	W‡PQR(Price Quote Reissue record number) W‡PQR4
Delete all PQR records	PQRD-ALL
Delete a specific PQR record	PQRD(PQR record number)(/ or -)(PQR record number) PQRD1 PQRD1/3 PQRD1-5
Delete a PQR record by name number	PQRD(PQR record number)N(name number) PQRDN2.1

TRAVEL JOURNAL RECORD TASKS FORMAT

Note: Changes to the <i>Travel Journal Record</i> (TJR) security feature requires the keyword SUBMGR and duty code 9 in the travel agent's <i>Employee Profile Record</i> (EPR).		
Activate Quick Refunds and Exchanges (QREX) functionality	W/PQREX‡ON	
	Note : Price Quote record functionality does not need to be active to use QREX functionality.	
Deactivate QREX functionality	W/PQREX‡OFF	
	Note : If QREX functionality is deactivated, it also automatically deactivates the Comparison Summary Inactive indicator.	
Display status of QREX functionality	W/PQREX‡*	
Make the Comparison Summary screen inactive	W/CSI‡ON	
	Note : You do not want any of the mask screens to display when using the FastPath linear entries. COMPARISON SUMMARY WILL NOT DISPLAY is shown in the TJR display.	
Make the Comparison Summary screen active	W/CSI‡OFF	
	Note: You do want the mask screens to display when using the FastPath linear entries. COMPARISON SUMMARY WILL DISPLAY is shown in the TJR display.
